

## CFI's Priority Peaks and Trail Maintenance Schedule, 2024

*Please consider serving as many days as possible on these peaks. They either have heavy use or trail crews working there this season. It is helpful to the trail crews if a Peak Steward is onsite to talk with hikers. It provides an opportunity to talk about the work of CFI and the Peak Steward program. Saturday is typically the busiest hiking day and trail work is often above treeline.*

<b>Peak (routes)</b>	<b>Trailwork dates</b>	<b>Notes</b>
Mt. Bierstadt (Guanella Pass)	N/A	CFI completed a sustainable route in 2016. Bierstadt sees up to 35,000 hiker-use days per year.
Mt. Blue Sky (Summit Lake)	Maintenance Crew : June 25- July 2, August 6-13	Blue Sky sees 10,000-15,000 hikers in a season. Please contact Hannah for parking instructions
Grays & Torreys Peaks (Grays Trailhead)	Maintenance Crew: August 27 -September 3, September 10-17	CFI continues many years of work here, performing trail delineation and construction above 12,700 ft.
Quandary Peak (Quandary Trailhead)	Maintenance Crew: June 25- July 2, August 6-13	CFI finished a sustainable route here in 2018 and continues to maintain the trail due to 35,000+ hiker use days here per year. Please contact Hannah for parking instructions.
Mt Sherman (Fourmile Creek)	N/A	Sherman sees 7,000-10,000 hiker use days due to proximity to the Denver Metro area.
Mts. Lincoln, Democrat, Bross (Kite Lake)	Maintenance Crew: July 16-29, September 17-24	The Decalibron loop gets up to 25,000 hiker-use days and has experienced access issues over the years
Mt. Harvard (North Cottonwood)	Maintenance Crew: June 4-11, July 2-9, July 22-29	Crews and volunteers will focus efforts near the Harvard/Columbia Junction and near tree line.
Mt Elbert (North, South and Blackcloud Trailheads)	Fixed-site Crew: 6/15-9/26 (N Elbert and Blackcloud)	CFI will have fixed-site crews on North Elbert and Blackcloud- performing reconstruction, maintenance, and restoration. CFI finished a sustainable route on South Elbert in 2020.
Mt Shavano (Shavano/Tabeguache Trailhead)	Fixed-site Crew: 6/15-9/26 Maintenance Crew: June 17-24	CFI owns mining claims at the summit of Shavano. CFI will continuing the third year of a 5-year project, building a sustainable summit route.
Mts Belford/Oxford (Missouri Gulch Trailhead)	Maintenance Crew: June 11-18	CFI will work on the large section of trail that was destroyed in an avalanche during the winter of 2018-2019.
Handies Peak (American Basin)	Maintenance Crew: July 30- August 6, August 13-20	Most of the maintenance work is below Sloan Lake, installing rock structures to prevent erosion and protect ptarmigan populations in the area.
